

Summer Reading Assignment 2014

Reading Logs are due on the first day of school. They will be counted toward your first quarter grade. It is an easy way to start the year off with an A on an assignment! There is also an extra credit option for those who would like to do a little extra reading.

Over the course of the summer you need to read at least 2 books. You are more than welcome to read nonfiction texts as well. You may also choose to read magazines. If you choose to read a magazine, you need to read all of the articles (not just look at the pictures :-). Two magazines will count as one book and you may use this option once only. You are expected to read at least one book in its entirety.

For ONE book that you have read, answer 3 questions from the following lists. Please be sure to answer in complete sentences, with correct spelling and punctuation. If you have chosen to read 2 magazines and one book, you must answer three questions based on your book that you have read, NOT the magazines. You can answer the questions in your Reader's Notebook. Or, you also have the option of answering the questions electronically. You just need to go to my website (through the school's website) and do it as if you were doing a Reader's Notebook entry.

Reader's Notebook Prompts for Fiction

1. Which character would you like to meet? Why?
2. Have you read anything similar to your book? How is it similar?
3. Describe the main character. Use specific details from the text.
4. Describe your favorite character. Use specific details from the text.
5. Describe your least favorite character. Use specific details from the text.
6. Describe the major conflict. What side are you on?
7. Describe the major conflict. How do you think it will be resolved?
8. Describe the setting. Use specific details from the text.
9. Describe the similarities and differences between you and the main character.
10. Does the title fit the story? Why or why not? If you had to change the title, what would it be? Why?
11. Draw an image from the story. Describe it with 4 specific details.
12. If you could meet the author, what would you ask him/her?
13. Make a prediction about what you think will happen next? Why?
