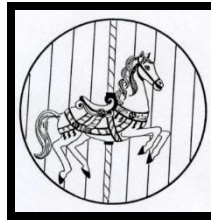

Dear Parents, families and guardians,


It is with great excitement that we inform you the Middle School will be offering a skills and drills basketball clinic come March 1st. The coaching staff of the Oak Bluffs Blazers would like to continue the interest and growth of basketball knowledge and skills among our students! Due to COVID-19 regulations *space is limited* and we will be accepting returning players first then the remaining slots will be filled on a first come first serve basis. We appreciate your interest and dedication to the game of basketball. Please think to yourself “am I truly interested?” before filling out the necessary paperwork and joining the clinic.

Students must have provided a physical exam to the school nurse that is dated after February 1, 2020 in order to participate.

We will be offering this opportunity to 6th, 7th and 8th graders. There will be ***strictly enforced*** COVID-19 rules and regulations:

1. **Masks MUST be worn at all times. Gaiters/ buffs, bandanas or masks with vents are not acceptable masks.**
2. **Students must follow school guidelines for health and must stay home if they feel unwell. See guidelines below.**
3. **Hands will be washed before entering the gym, halfway through the session and at the end of practice**
4. **Bring your own personal water bottle and hand sanitizer**
5. **Social distancing will be maintained throughout the drills**
6. **There will be NO loitering or socializing before or after the clinic. Parents MUST not drop off early or be late to pick up.**
7. **Attendance will be taken**
8. **Failure to follow these guidelines will result in students disqualification from practices**

The coaching staff, administration and the school nurse have all met to discuss this opportunity and approved the below schedule.

Again, we will only be practicing as an Oak Bluffs School Cohort. We will not be traveling school to school. We will only be practicing with Oak Bluffs grade level peers. Please keep in mind that despite best efforts to maintain social distancing there is still a possibility that your child may be considered a close contact if another child in the clinic tests positive for COVID-19.

Health Guidelines:
When in doubt, stay home!

STAY HOME if you have any of the symptoms listed.

Below is the full list of symptoms for which caregivers should monitor their children:

- Fever (100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or higher), chills, or shaking chills
- Cough (not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Headache when in combination with other symptoms
- Muscle aches or body aches
- Nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain or diarrhea
- Fatigue, when in combination with other symptoms
- Nasal congestion or runny nose (not due to other known causes, such as allergies)
